- Description of issue: This file has been detected as a virus "Real Protect-LS!01a2893517x8" and Quarantined. I've contacted the OpenLP developer and he (raoul see below line) ask me if I would report it to McAfee for him from the OpenLP Forum. I'll try to white-list it myself for now. Please help! Is it a virus. I'm running on the new Windows 11 on a brand new HP laptop. Intel Core i7.

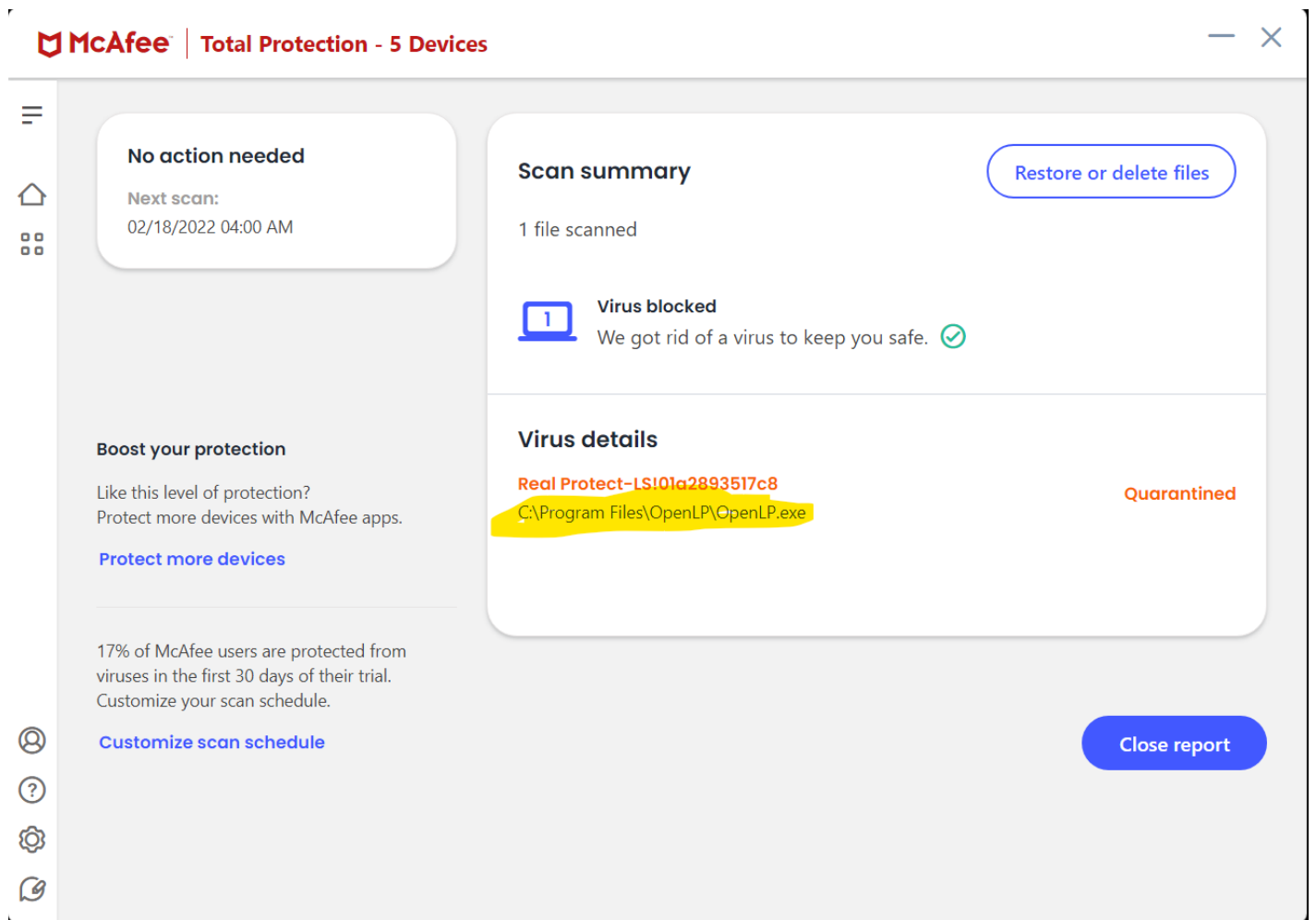
